HONG KONG IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT PERMITS DEPENDENTS OF PROFESSIONALS AND INVESTORS IN APPROPRIATE IMMIGRATION CLASSIFICATIONS TO SEEK EMPLOYMENT WITHOUT APPLYING FOR A WORK PERMIT

The Hong Kong Immigration Department recently announced that dependents of persons admitted as investors or professionals will be eligible to seek employment without first applying for a work permit. The change in policy and procedure is aimed at making Hong Kong a more attractive destination for investors, professionals and their families.
