CHERTOFF ANNOUNCES EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY PROTECTED  
STATUS (TPS) FOR HONDURANS, NICARAGUANS, AND SALVADORANS**

**Re-registration Periods Will Be Announced by Publication in the Federal Register**

U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Secretary Michael Chertoff has announced the extension of Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for eligible Hondurans, Nicaraguans, and Salvadorans for an additional 18-month period. This announcement impacts approximately 315,000 people nationwide who will be eligible for re-registration for TPS in the coming months.

Existing TPS designations will expire on July 5, 2007 for Hondurans and Nicaraguans, and on September 9, 2007 for Salvadorans. Regulations concerning re-registration will be forthcoming in the Federal Register.
