

U.S. CITIZENSHIP & IMMIGRATION SERVICES (CIS) ANNOUNCES AUTOMATIC EXTENSION OF EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION FOR QUALIFYING HONDURANS, NICARAGUANS, AND EL SALVADORANS IN TEMPORARY PROTECTED STATUS (TPS)

Earlier this year U.S. Citizenship & Immigration Services (CIS) announced the extension of Temporary Protected States for Hondurans, Nicaraguans, and El Salvadorans. Subsequently the re-registration period for Hondurans and Nicaraguans was extended until December 30, 2008.

The CIS has also announced the automatic six-month extension of employment authorization for qualifying Honduran and Nicaraguan applicants until July 5, 2009. Work authorization for El Salvadorans will be automatically extended for six months until September 9, 2009.
